- 2015 CAFA Budget: Motion by Koseck, seconded by Osborne to reinsert \$8,000.00 into the 2015 Chelsea Area Fire Authority Budget, 3-702.6, Chief's Vehicle Allowance and reduce 3-702.0, Wages - Chief by \$8,000.00. Carried unanimous.

Motion by Maier, seconded by Osborne for Chief Payeur to prepare the 2015 Chelsea Area Fire Authority Budget as amended and present it to the participating municipalities for approval. Carried unanimous.

New Business:

Bylaws: Anderson requested that Board Members give him recommended changes and he will bring them back to the December 16, 2014 CAFA Board Meeting for review.

Reports:

- 1. <u>Chairman</u> Anderson informed the Board that he had approached the City of Chelsea regarding the repairs needed to the CAFA Fire Station and the City of Chelsea is not going to pay for any repairs to the station. CAFA can use the station as is or look for a new location.
- 2. <u>Vice Chairman</u> Maier feels that CAFA still needs to solicit bids for the cost of repairing the CAFA Fire Station.

- **4.** <u>Trustees</u> Motion by Maier, seconded by Osborne to have a notice within the 2015 Chelsea Area Fire Authority Budget stating that some line items within the budget may change due to union negotiations. Carried unanimous.

Augustine Syrovy had concerns regarding CAFA paying for repairs to a building owned by the City of Chelsea with tax payer dollars.

Harold Moore stated that CAFA would be silly to put money into the CAFA Station since it is owned by the City. CAFA approach the City of Chelsea to purchase the building or have the City of Chelsea not require that the main fire station be within the city limits of Chelsea.
